

### Rev. Dr. George Warren Campbell

February 9, 1930—March 19, 2024



We share our deepest condolences and sympathies with Gail and the rest of the Campbell family, at the fulfillment of George's earthly life. We celebrate him into the loving grace of his Creator, and remember fondly his life and witness to Christ's love through his ministry.

Hillside Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) of Kansas City, MO celebrates the life of Minister Emeritus, Rev. George Campbell, on Saturday, May 11th, at 11:00 am.

Visitation will begin at 10:00 am, with refreshments in the Lounge, as the family receives guests in the Sanctuary. In lieu of floral arrangements, monetary gifts are received to the Hillside Memorial Fund, for the purpose of establishing a named endowment in George's honor.

Rev. Campbell served as Hillside's Senior Minister from 1983 through 1995. upon his retirement from full-time ministry, George served many congregations in the Kansas City area as Interim Minister, guiding transitions and helping congregations navigate between settled ministers.

George's service at Hillside is marked by celebrating the 30th and 40th anniversaries of the congregation, during a period of some of the most active participation in the congregation's history. His voice was not only heard from the pulpit in proclaiming Good News, but also in song through his involvement in musical theatre and church music performances.

Please remember the Campbell family in comforting prayers in the coming days—especially George's loving wife Gail, who the last few years served not only as his companion, but as his primary caregiver. Such dedicated service is a true testimony to the presence and grace of God's love.

For a life well lived, and well loved, we give thanks to God our Redeemer.

The turtle on the back signifies the land and the cycles of renewal. "Confluence" symbolizes the merging of people, ideas, and cultures into a unified family. In Kansas City, we come together, care for each other, and find our home in this place of unity and diversity.



Many thanks to the Property Committee, the Learning Tree Class, the Men's Ministry and other volunteers for their hard work in the Library and Lounge. With new carpet installed, shelves are being replaced and books are being sorted and reshelved. Soon both spaces will be back in action and completed for the next chapter of ministry at Hillside. Funds for the project came from the Learning Tree Class and the Ministerial Relief and Assistance Program of the Pension Fund of the Christian Church.
