# Eastertide: The Season of New Life and Promise


Easter is a "moveable feast" which, unlike Christmas with its set date, falls on the Sunday after the full moon following March 21. It can be easy to fall back into "life as normal" after observing Easter. But, the season of Easter – 49 days – is Christendom's most meaningful and historic celebration.

## Historical Roots of Easter Season

The Easter Season – or Eastertide – is seven weeks after Easter. It seems likely that Eastertide was modelled after the Jewish festival of Shavuot, The Festival of Weeks, which was seven weeks long and ended with the celebration of Shavuot on the 50th day. In Christian tradition, the Easter season leads us to celebrate Pentecost, the gift of God's Holy Spirit on the 50th day. This year, Pentecost is May 19th.

# Finding Meaning in the Tradition

As with Christmas, there may be an emotional slump after Easter. Eastertide is, therefore, a good time to engage in something new in mission, something daring and innovative. Gather up your unused kitchen items and donate them to a refugee resettlement program. Start going to a bible study group or other fellowship opportunity. Make an effort to keep the "spirit" of Easter going in your life through intentional practices and efforts that remind you of new life and resurrection.



#### **Eastertide Sermon Series**

The weeks after Easter are intended to be times of focused devotion, and attention to the ways God's love in Christ is showing up in our lives. The scriptures will remind us of the ways the post-resurrection Christ appears to his followers, and how they responded to his new commandments.

Centrally, the command is to love, a refrain found throughout the Gospel of John, as well as the First Letter of John—which many scholars consider to be an early commentary on the gospels themes, including this commandments to love one another as Christ has loved us. If you're waiting for a good time to get to church, this is it! With the themes of responding to new life and discovering God's abundant love, this is the perfect way to invite a friend to Hillside.




