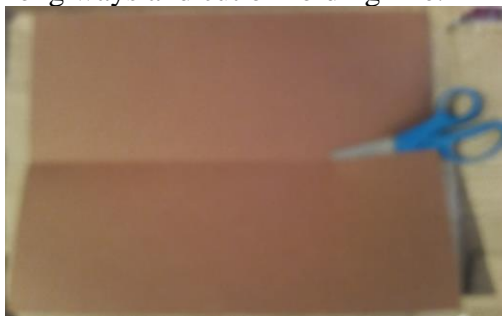
“BE CARING” and make Craft Bandages

Supplies: (for 4 bandages)

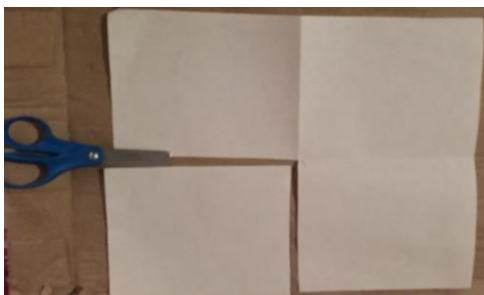
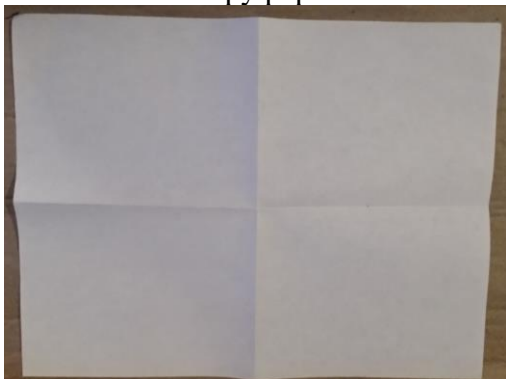
- 4 sheets 8 ½ x 11 brown construction paper
- 1 sheet 8 ½ x 11 white copy paper
- 4 pieces Red construction paper 6 ½ x 4 ½
- Pen, pencil, colored pencil, crayon, or marker
- Scissors
- Glue stick or elemers glue

Directions:

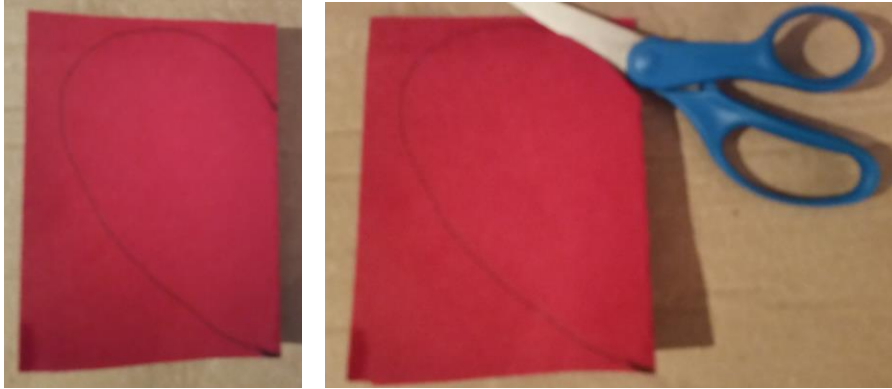
1. Fold brown construction paper in half long ways and cut on folding line.



2. Take white copy paper and fold into 4 equal pieces and cut on folded lines.



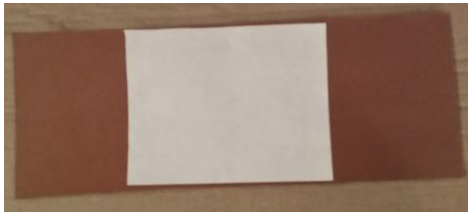
3. Take red construction paper and fold in half draw half heart and then cut out



4. On one half of brown construction paper glue red heart in the middle.



5. On other half of brown construction paper glue one of the white pieces of paper in the middle.



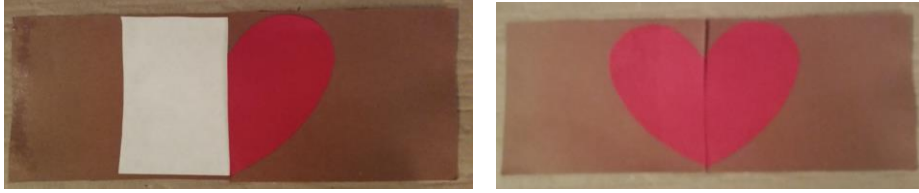
6. Take brown construction paper that has heart on it and cut in half.



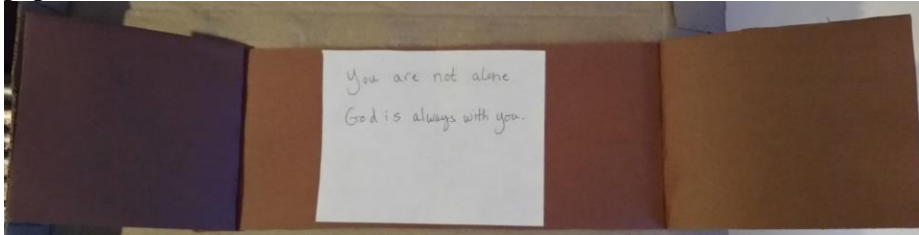
7. Put glue only on outer right and left sides of the brown construction paper that has white paper on it.



8. Place cut pieces of brown construction paper with heart halves on top of brown construction paper with white paper that you just glued matching heart pieces up. Press down the outer sides to stick into place.



9. Fold back the two sides and write **your** message of hope, caring, or encouragement on the white piece of paper.



Give you finished bandages to friends, persons who need encouragement, or Rev. Andy to take when he does hospital visits.
